

## NEW CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROAD

At a meeting held by the village communities, the inhabitants of Downwille and Upwille decided on a joint construction of a road between the two villages.

During the planning of the road it turned out, however, that the land between the two villages had several implications and was therefore a subject of very different interests. There followed an encounter of interests associated with agricultural production, nature conservation, forestry and individual land owners. Finally a meeting is organised, which is to be attended both by building contractors and representatives of these groups.

## CONSTRUCTION OF THE SKI SLOPE

The villagers of Hillside gathered at a meeting organised by the local community, to discuss the development possibilities brought on by tourism associated with the nearby mountains.

Specifically, three variants for the construction of a ski slope had been presented to them in the local development plan.

At the meeting it turns out that they are faced with the decision whether to preserve the existent trekking tourism and sale of local products, or to build a small hotel, ski slope and cable railway, and thus to attract even more tourists.

There follows an encounter of interests affiliated with agricultural production, nature conservation, forestry, sustainable tourism and economic development of the village.

## CONSTRUCTION OF THE HYDROELECTRIC POWER STATION

The inhabitants of Sidebrook gathered at a meeting, at which the hydroelectric power station construction plan was presented to them.

Construction of the planned hydroelectric power station construction means deepening of the riverbed and building of a dam and reservoir by flooding the land along the river banks.

During the study of different variants it turns out that both the river and the land alongside the river have several implications and that they are subject to different interests. There follows a confrontation of interests between agricultural production, nature conservation, fishery, land owners, electric power production, and economic development of the town.
